CCHPC NEW RULES FOR COVID-19 PLAN

1. Max of 300 persons on the CCHPC grounds at one time excluding volunteers.
2. Entries
 - a. Preferred method will be online entries, link will be provided prior to the event with a set close time. Individual times may vary, check the link for each event.
 - b. If online entry is not possible, please print the showbill form at home, fill out, place with payment in an envelope provided by participant. Drop off to the office staff in a basket via the window on the south side.
 - c. If participant is unable to print, some forms will be available on site.
 - d. No participants may enter the office except staff or board member. If you must interact with office staff, a mask/face covering must be worn.
3. Payment
 - a. Preferred via PayPal to cchpc.treasurer@gmail.com
 - b. Second preference via check. Place in envelope you provide and place in basket thru the office window.
 - c. Only exact cash accepted if necessary. No cash back.
4. All buildings, playground, bleachers, and picnic tables will be off limits. Cookshack and bathrooms are closed.
5. Classes with more than 20 riders will be split.
6. Minimum 6 foot distance must be maintained always including while in the show ring and practice area.
7. Ribbons will only be available for pickup after Open Ranch Class and Mystery Race for Playday events.
8. Speed and 5D Barrel payback will be paid via PayPal or check. Be sure information is correct on entry forms!
9. Participants will be asked to stay within vicinity of your trailer as much as possible. Spectators will stay in vicinity of vehicle they arrived in if separate from a trailer.
10. Each participant/spectator/volunteer is responsible to provide the following for their personal use and to use as necessary:
 - a. Hand Sanitizer
 - b. Gloves
 - c. Mask
